

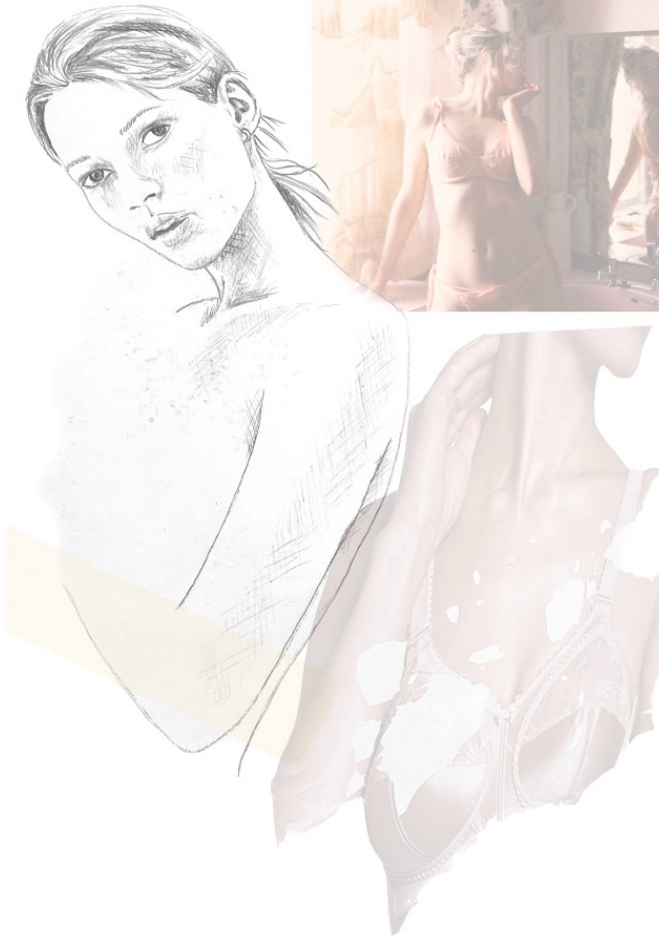

Having chosen the bed, the next step is to dress it with the underlinens
 (sheets and pillowcases) and then the top linens (blankets, quilts,
 duvets, bedspreads, and covers). This is the
 most important part of the bed, for it is the

 life. The most basic, and affordable, approach is to
 dress the bed in a simple, solid-colored sheet,
 with a matching pillowcase, and a matching

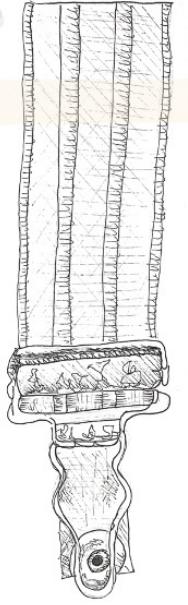
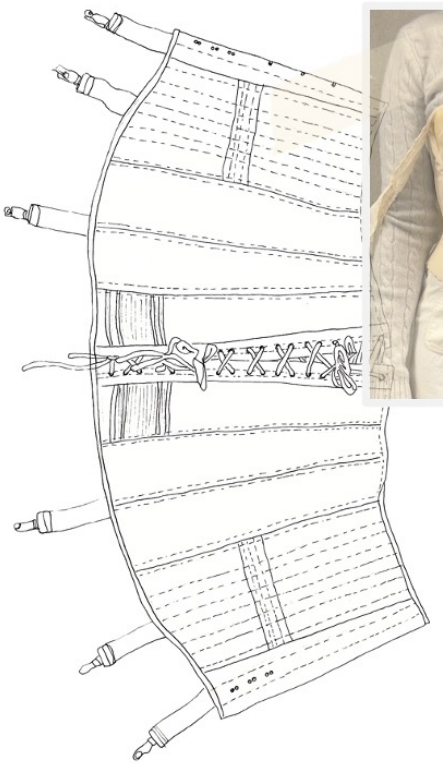
THE BED

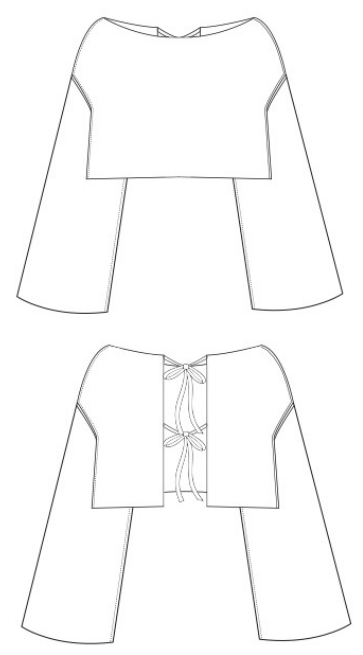
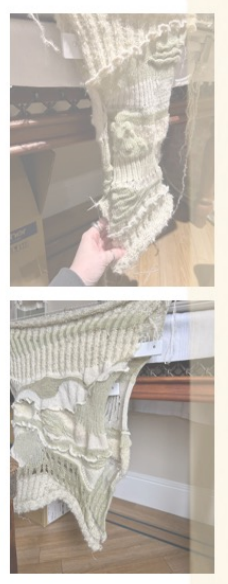
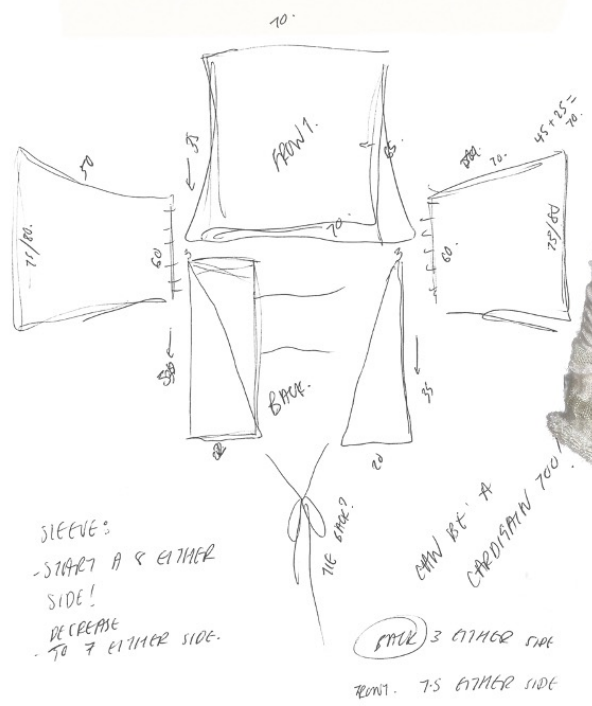
In a bedroom, the range of possibilities can be daunting, but the only truly essential piece of furniture, the bed, the space will follow naturally from there.

For a stripped-down, back-to-basics look, let the mattress on the floor (page 27).

Searching for a decorative bedstead is a challenge. For a period or eclectic look, let the bed be your guide. Four-poster beds range from elaborately carved Gothic (page 22) to neoclassical (page 40), majestic Empire (page 23), or simple mahogany (page 51). Or choose sleigh beds with swan supports and lyre-shaped feet (page 24) or a neoclassical Empire (page 25). Period campaign beds like those on page 34 bring the spirit of the outdoors into any room. Metal bedsteads, either adorned with graceful scrollwork or plain (page 77), are easy to find.

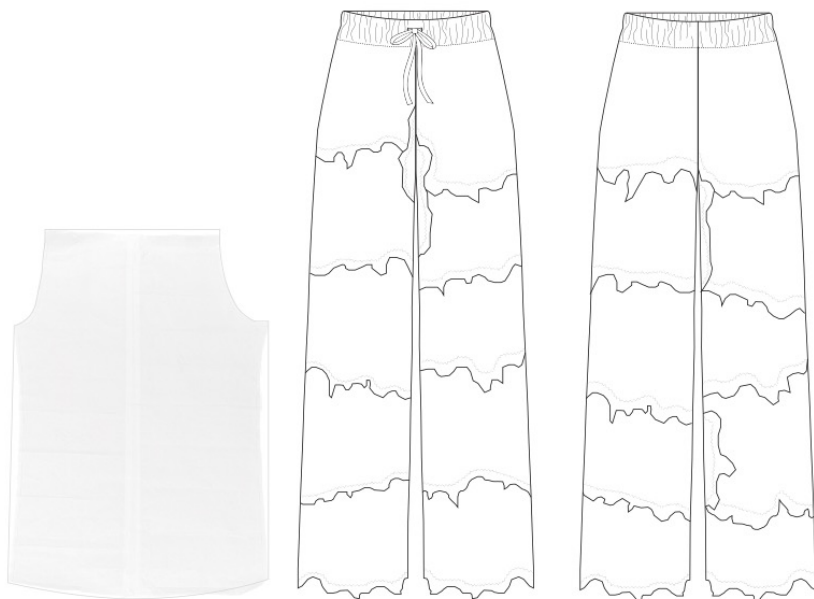
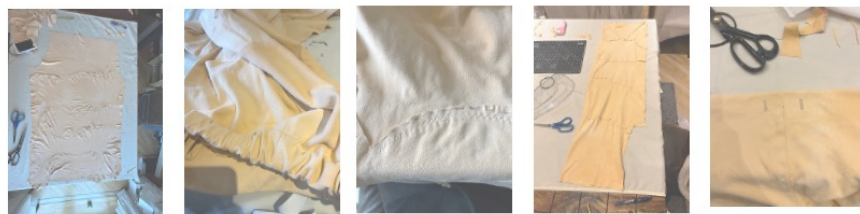
All sorts of objects can be reclaimed and used as headboards. Antiques shops, auction houses, and architectural salvage yards are good hunting grounds. Old French paneling, a mirrored period trapezoid, or an ornamental mirror can be mounted on the wall as a headboard. A carved mantel piece, a vintage period picture frame, or a pair of flat iron can be repurposed as a headboard. A simple wooden headboard can be made from a salvaged door or a piece of wood.
